STORY POINT:

Jesus chose disciples to follow Him.

UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

John 3:30 "He must become greater; I must become less."

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

Is Jesus God or human? Jesus is both fully God and fully human.

BIBLE PASSAGES:

Read Matthew 4:18-21, 9:9; Mark 1-3; Luke 5-6

TALK ABOUT IT

What Does It Say?

1. Who chose disciples to follow him?
Jesus chose disciples to follow Him.
2. What job did Simon Peter, Andrew, James, and John have before following Jesus? *They were fishermen.*
3. What job did Matthew have before following Jesus?
Matthew was a tax collector.
4. How many disciples did Jesus choose? *12*

Why Does It Matter?

Jesus chose fishermen, tax collectors, and others to become His disciples. In all, He chose twelve men to follow Him, minister with Him, and to join Him on His mission to rescue sinners. We become Jesus' disciples, too, when we believe that He died for our sin and rose again.

How can we can join in Jesus' mission to rescue sinners? *by sharing the good news about His life, death, and resurrection*

FOR FUN

Jesus chose disciples to follow Him.
