THIS WEEK'S STORY:

Jesus Healed Ten Men

STORY POINT:

Jesus loves all people.

UNIT MEMORY VERSE:

Isaiah 53:4-5 "Yet he himself bore our sicknesses,...punishment for our peace was on him, and we are healed by his wounds."

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

Why did God create people? God created people to love Him and give Him glory.

BIBLE PASSAGES:

Read Luke 17

TALK ABOUT IT

What Does It Say?

How many men cried out to Jesus? ten

Why did the men need Jesus' help? They had a skin disease.

What did Jesus tell the men to do? show themselves to the priest

What happened as the men went to the priest? Jesus healed ten men with a skin disease.

What did one man do that no one else did? He went back to thank Jesus and give praise to God,

Why Does It Matter?

Only one man came back to thank Jesus for healing him. It is almost Thanksgiving! This week's lesson reminds us to be grateful-what are you grateful for?

FOR FUN

Sit in a circle as a family. Toss a beanbag or small ball to each other. When the person receives the beanbag or ball, they are to say something for which they are thankful to God for. When they are finished, they toss the beanbag or ball to someone else in the circle. Decide how many times to pass the beanbag and ball around the family.

TO SERVE

Get some thank you notes or use a piece of notebook or construction paper. Write a thank you note to someone who has recently given you something or done something nice for your family. It can be a friend who you are thankful for their friendship or someone in your house who loves you and has shown you kindness. Once you have completed the thank you note, mail or deliver it to the person.

Another option would be to write God a thank you note to thank Him for who He is and His love for you. You could post it in your house in a place where you can see it often as a reminder of how you are thankful for God.
