Position Summary: Care Ministry meets people at the lowest points of their lives and, through crisis discipleship, helps them to navigate through their pain to a place where their faith is increased.

Care Ministry serves Fellowship Bible Church through biblical counseling, Soul Care, Stephen Ministry, ReGen, benevolence, and other care and compassion ministries led by volunteers.

Essential Skills & Experience:

- Master's degree from a seminary in Bible or Theology.
- A degree or extensive courses or much experience in counseling.
- A degree or extensive courses or much experience in education.
- Ability to teach large groups.
- Ability to promote vision.

Position Responsibilities:

- Leads our church through providing pastoral care for our body through individual counseling and leadership to ministry programs such as ReGen, Soul Care, and Stephen's Ministry.
- Works with our Student and Children's leadership to create pathways for partnership with parents at Fellowship for the discipling and care of their children.
- Displays a visible presence on Sunday mornings, especially in the communities of our older attenders, letting them know that they are seen, valued, and loved.
- Ensures widows, shut-ins, and those hospitalized are cared for whether that be personal visits by that pastor, visits/calls by the Pastor on Call, visits by the lay Care Pastor (Geoff Wiggins), or some other designee.
- Provides leadership to Fellowship Bible Church through active participation on the Leadership Team.
- Works with the Executive Team and Elders to birth and lead a Deacon ministry at Fellowship to help us shepherd the flock better.

Markers of an Ideal Candidate:

- Must have the heart and gifting of a shepherd who delights in being a part of and working through team.
- Strong experience in organizational leadership is mandatory.
